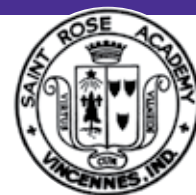

Judy Halter Memorial Scholarship

Living the Catholic Faith

Judy Halter (1939-2017), a graduate of St. Rose Academy, Class of 1957, lifelong resident of Vincennes, and member of the Catholic community, lived her faith through trying hardships, including a chronic illness that confined her for much of her adult life and greatly limited her opportunities. This scholarship offering is a result of one of the many times that Judy's living out the Catholic faith and her undying spirit of enthusiasm touched someone along the way.

In the 1970's, Judy worked at St John's Parish. She became aware of an international student at Vincennes University, who shared her strong Catholic faith, and was in need of assistance in order to remain in the United States, have a place to stay, and to continue to work towards her education goals. Judy invited this girl into her home, where she already had three busy teenagers of her own.

That girl, went on to graduate, obtain a PHD, become successful, and raise a family of her own. Upon Judy's death, that girl, now a grown woman, wished to honor Judy and her enduring kindness and generosity, with a scholarship. A scholarship to something that Judy dearly loved, the Catholic school system, and the wonderful students of Rivet, pursuing exciting dreams, cloaked with the armor of their faith.

It is in that image of God's enthusiasm that shined in Judy, that this scholarship is presented.

2023 INDIANA ACAD

On Saturday, April 29th, Rivet Middle School participated in the 2023 Indiana Academic Bowl at Sarah Scott Middle School in Terre Haute, IN. Upon completion of the area competition, Rivet placed 1st in three disciplines (English, Social Studies, and Interdisciplinary), 2nd in Science, and 4th in Math in the class 4 division.

Rivet's highest-scoring Social Studies team placed 10th overall in the state rankings for class 4. The Rivet English Bowl team recorded a perfect score of 25 questions correctly answered at the area event. After the statewide results were calculated, the Rivet Middle School English Bowl team was awarded the state championship, posting the highest score of any of the 190+ schools that entered a squad in the English Bowl competition. The state championship-winning team consisted of three 8th-grade students: Isabela Pacheco, Bryn Duckworth, and Adalyn Ray.

Team coaches were Susie Blackburn for Math, Trey Desjardin for Social Studies, and Nick Carrithers for English.

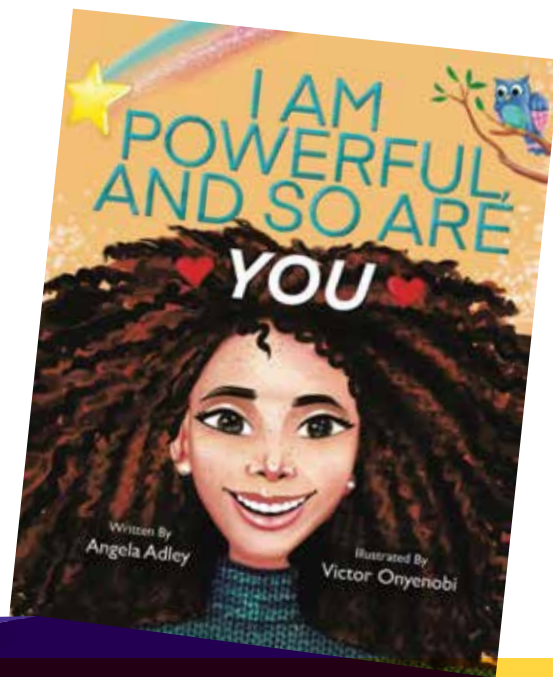

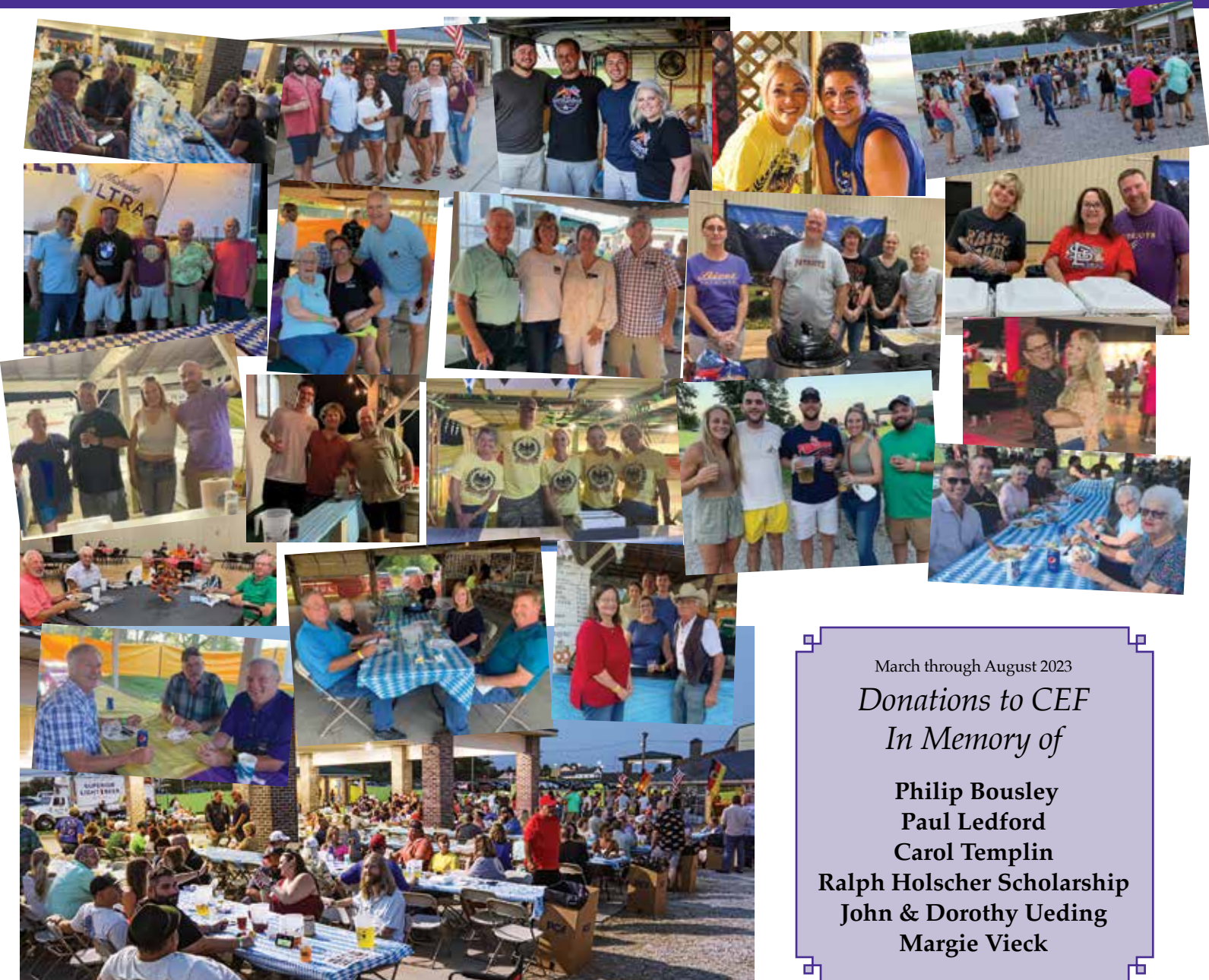
